This is a test event, so this year it is limited to 150 runners.

The Snetterton Race Track Marathon takes place at the iconic Snetterton Race circuit. The circuit has been recently extended to 5km, using the entry and exit roads we have produced a pristine 7km lap. This is one of the best opportunities to run a traffic free marathon on excellent roads in East Anglia. There will be absolutely no traffic, no pedestrians and no dogs! Although gently undulating, the course has consistently delivered a huge percentage of PBs for our half marathon and 10k events. The looped nature of the course makes it an ideal location for spectators (all are welcome!) as well as an easy event to judge your pacing to perfection.

Race Date: Sunday November 18th 2018.

Race start: 10:30am.

Race registration, will be open from 08:30-10:10am. Please allow yourself plenty of time to collect your race number and timing chip.

Race Venue: Snetterton Circuit, Norwich, Norfolk NR16 2JU

Distance: Classic marathon distance of 42.195km (26.2mi) covered using 6 laps of a 7km course. Course distance will be certified by AUKCM measurer and carry a course measurement certificate.

Entries: Maximum entries: 150 as it is in its first year. You must be 18 years or older on the day of the race.

Time Limit: 6 hours

Prizes: There will be prizes available for top three males and females as well as all age-category winners.

Permit: A Race permit will be applied for from UK Athletics (UKA/runbritain). UKA

Facilities: Café, toilets, showers, baggage store, on-site free car parking, Water and electrolyte drinks will be available on twice every lap.
